**PORT FEES AND SERVICE FEES FOR PORT USERS OF
SHIPBUILDING INDUSTRY SPLIT D.D.**

**Attachment 1 to the “Rulebook on terms and conditions of harbor use on
the harbour area of special purposes - Shipyard Split”, Pv826.1**

Split, 1st April 2022.

According to the Article 7 of "Rulebook about terms and conditions of harbor use on the harbour area of special purposes — Shipyard Split", Pv826.1 dated June 13th 2014., which prescribes harbour rules usage conditions, Management Board of Brodosplit d.d. determines the following port fees and service fees for port users.

By accepting these fees, users acknowledge the rules contained in the Rulebook.

Provisions and clarifications regarding fees and charges:

- In this file, term "Brodosplit" implies all Brodosplit Group companies.
- Term "calculation period" in this file means period of work that is defined by chart 1 (Working hours) and chart 2 (Increase in prices for overtime work)
- All vessels sailing under foreign flags are invoiced in Euros, the currency in which the payments are made as well, according to the Croatian National Bank exchange rate on the day of invoice, while vessels sailing under the Croatian flag are issued in Croatian kuna.
- VAT is not included in the expressed prices.
- Unless otherwise stated, all prices refer to an indivisible billing unit (m', GT, hour, day, week, month).
- Unless otherwise stated, the longest calculation period is one calendar month, while the shortest calculation period is the indivisible unit of measure (m', GT, hour, day, week).
- An indivisible day implies period from 00:00 to 24:00
- Legal and natural persons, that use the shore in the port area of Brodosplit, are required to report in writing about the stay of their vessel in the harbour with correct information about the time they have spent moored.
- All work done after Brodosplit's working hours is considered as overtime work.
- If some work or operations are not determined by this document, then they will be arranged by a special agreement.
- Price of work during rain, snow or heavy wind, on a client's demand and only if Brodosplit accepts such a request, will be increased by 100% in relation to the valid price of the current calculation period.
- The term „waiting“ implies:
 - waiting for workers or the inability to use technical means because of rain, snow, wind, elemental disasters or other circumstances that can affect the safety and the feasibility of planned operations,
 - waiting for a vessel's arrival, a cargo delivery to the destination or vehicle placing,
 - waiting caused by a vessel not being technically ready
 - all other waiting times that were not caused by Brodosplit.
- The service user is obliged to announce its arrival and needs in accordance with the said Rulebook.
- When the work in the regular working hours or overtime hours is cancelled before the end of a part time shift or a shift, the rest of the time until the end of it will be considered as awaiting time.
- Brodosplit is not obliged to storage cargo which arrival was not arranged in advance nor is responsible for any damages that might result from it.

- On Brodosplit's demand, a vessel is always obliged to make available the vessel's means of mechanization. In case of absence or malfunction of the mechanization, Brodosplit will, at the vessel's request and within Brodosplit's technical capabilities, provide their own mechanization and charge the service of renting technical means and work force according to calculation period and a currently valid price list.
- A vessel is responsible for a damage which was made to Brodosplit's premises or technical means, which was not caused by Brodosplit (a record certified by the client or the executor required)
- Brodosplit is responsible for the work of their staff, as well as for the functioning of their technical resources, and they respond for their omissions to service users.
- Brodosplit is not responsible for:
 - damages incurred during cargo handling, if they happened with no fault of Brodosplit's hired workers and technical means,
 - work disorders that were caused by the effects of factors that act independently from Brodosplit's system:
 - o elemental disasters (earthquakes, high or low temperatures, strong winds...)
 - o power outage
 - o orders from national authorities
 - work disorders that arise due to accidents (serious injuries...),
 - work disorders that happen as consequences of customs, sanitary, veterinary, phytopathological or other controls performed by state authorities, damages which may arise due to fires or due to usage of fire extinguishers,
 - damages caused by circumstances which Brodosplit, under normal conditions, may not influence.
- Brodosplit has a lien of cargo retention if a service user, after a written warning, does not pay the Brodosplit's costs in the foreseeable period.
- In case of necessary operational transfer, the ship owner is obliged to move the vessel at his own expense.

All of the above-mentioned cases include a certified record between a client and the service provider.

These tariffs and fees replace previously valid ones and are applicable from 1st April, 2022.

Note to Table 8 (Rental of forklifts):

- The one-day calculation base implies regular working hours from 7.00 to 15.00 hours.
- A forklift rental commences from the moment it leaves its garage/workshop and it lasts until it comes back to the starting point.
- The prices listed do not include a forklift transport to and from the renter, which is charged extra.
- These prices do not include the engagement of a forklift operator. Service of a forklift operator is calculated separately, in the same billing interval as the hire of a forklift, based on prices from table 13.
- Minimum hire of a forklift operator outside of Brodosplit area is 3 hours.
- A time spent waiting for technical means to start working, which was not caused by Brodosplit's fault, shall be charged in the amount of 50% of the price foreseen for the means.
- Waiting in overtime hours is charged in the amount of 50% of the increased price for overtime work of the specific calculating period.
- It is necessary to announce extension of rental period at least 24 hours before its expiry.
- A renter is obliged to return a forklift in working order and without any damage, otherwise is obliged to compensate all the estimated damage.
- The hiring price does not include a cargo insurance.
- A forklift is given with a full tank so the renter is obligated to return it as such.
- A renter is obliged to immediately report any malfunction on the hour meter and stops his work until repair is done.
- Brodosplit retains the right to ask for the return of technical means in any moment.

- The stated rental price of the floating crane does not include the cost of tow, preparation and dismantling of the crane, and the assistance of the tug boat. These costs are calculated on a special arrangement depending on the place of engagement and technical requirements of the required operations.
- The daily crane rentals arranged individually!
- The hiring price does not include a cargo insurance.
- A time spent waiting for technical means to start working, which was not caused by Brodosplit's fault, shall be charged in the amount of 50% of the price foreseen for the means.
- Waiting in overtime hours is charged in the amount of 50% of the increased price for overtime work of the specific calculating period.
- A renter is obliged to return a rented technical means in working order and without any damage, otherwise is obliged to compensate all the estimated damage.
- Brodosplit retains the right to ask for the return of technical means in any moment.

- A time spent waiting for technical means to start working, which was not caused by a Brodosplit's fault, shall be charged in the amount of 50% of the price foreseen for the means
- Waiting in overtime hours is charged in the amount of 50% of the increased price for overtime work of the specific calculating period
- A renter is obliged to return the rented technical equipment in working order and without any damage, otherwise is obliged to compensate all the estimated damage

- The rental of other technical equipment (such as mobile crane, tractor, lorry...) commences to run from the moment the device leaves its garage/workshop and it lasts until it comes back to starting point
- The price for the lorry Iveco 8t refers to the work done inside 30km radius from Brodosplit area
- The rental price for the specified lorry outside of that radius is 2.00 Eur/km.
- The price for the freight vehicle Iveco Daily refers to the work done inside 30km radius from Brodosplit area
- The rental price for the specified lorry outside of that radius is 1.50 Eur/km.

- For non-regular scaffolding (hanging scaffolding or similar) or minimal scaffolding area below 3m³ the price is to be calculated as per separate agreement
- For pricing purposes the maximum size of pedestal is 1m³. Each additional m³ is calculated as a new pedestal.

- In one day all equipment and machinery with maintenance, electricity requirements and operators are included, within all the shifts.
- It is charged as per meters of vessel's LOA per day. All equipment for maintenance, electricity and operators are included and also security and all services needed to fulfill rules and regulations for keeping the vessel at berth.
